Mission: One of the key missions of The Respiratory Health Association of Metropolitan Chicago is to support research into the causes and treatment of lung disease. To that end, we commit a significant portion of our annual budget to fund promising research projects in biomedical and behavioral research.

Research Grants: The focus of the research grant program is to provide seed funding for **innovative** research projects that will improve our understanding of lung health and disease and lead to improvements in preventing, treating and curing lung diseases.

Amount: Maximum of \$50,000/year for up to 2 years

Eligibility Criteria: Individuals with a full-time faculty appointment at the level of assistant or associate professor. Applicants must be a United States citizen or United States resident.

To Apply: We will follow NIH application guidelines, with the exception of a 15 page limit for the research plan.
