Prescription Assistance Information

There are key programs available to assist you with the high cost of prescription medications. Each program has different guidelines for participants. Most programs require that patients enroll themselves. Many have income guidelines that must be met. Below is a brief description of the programs available for adults and the contact information to call for further information.

1. Know the name of your medications
2. Know what company makes your medication

Eligibility: All Illinois, Wisconsin, Kansas, Missouri and Vermont residents are eligible regardless of immigration status. This is a discount mail order service to purchase prescriptions. Purchasing your medication refills through I-SaveRx can save you 25-80% off U.S. retail prices.
